

Easter International Cup Code of Conduct

For all teams, players, coaches, administrators, and the traveling delegation

- All players, coaches, administrators, parents and referees will be shown the respect and courtesy in a professional manner.
- Referees and tournament staff will be shown courtesy and respect throughout the tournament. All should recognize that mistakes will occur ; but, all are trying their best.
- Opponents will be shown courtesy and respect, even in adversity.
- The behavior of the team and the entire teams' delegation is the responsibility of the team, coaches, managers, and club directors.
- Proper conduct, respect, and behavior is expected throughout the duration of the event, including time at the partner hotel properties.
- **HOTELS:** All traveling parties should follow hotel policies and maintain appropriate behavior at the hotels. Damages at the hotel will be the responsibility of the teams. All youth and players should have adult supervision in hotel common areas. Hotels have the right to contact the tournament directors with issues with teams and team members.
- **Appropriate process to address concerns and issues:**
 - Official team staff members (coaches, directors, listed team managers) can address concerns/ issues at the site or tournament headquarters. This must be done in a calm and courteous manner. We cannot discuss team issues with individual parents/ players. Tournament headquarters is at Gosling Sports Fields.
- **Conduct not acceptable:**
 - Referee interactions: Post match discussions with referees is not allowed.
 - Poor conduct in post match actions will be taken seriously and may result in the teams' termination of the tournament. This includes the actions of the teams' fans/ delegation. Verbal abuse and physical confrontation cannot occur with the opponents or the referees.
 - If there is an issue, it can be discussed at tournament headquarters with the tournament directors. Tournament headquarters is at Gosling Sports Fields.
 - The tournament maintains the right to discipline teams in addition to any actions taken by the referees during a game.
